We, the undersigned, hereby consent and agree that the market and/or breeding animals(s) described on this entry application may, at the discretion of the HCFJLS management, be tested, evaluated, and/or analyzed for: 1) the improper use of substances not approved by the DAR and/or USDA; and/or 2) any method of altering or tampering with the natural conformation of any part of the animal's body. Improper usage or tampering will result in disqualification of the animal entry along with the exhibitor sanctions as established in the HCFLS catalog. All entry applications must be signed by the exhibitor, and parent or guardian if the exhibitor is less than 18 years of age. All 4H members' entries MUST have a signature from the Chapter leader certifying that the youth exhibitor has met all requirements to show in the HCFLS show. Incomplete signatures constitute no entry.

We, the undersigned, have read and voluntarily signed this release and waiver for liability and indemnity agreement, and further agree that no oral representations, statements, or inducements apart from the above written agreement have been made. Purpose of Form
