



State Fair of Texas Entry Cheat Sheet

Pan Am entries are entered and paid for by the exhibitor/family

1. Read and carefully review the Schedule, General Rules, Contest/Show rules found in Exhibitor Handbook - click [HERE](#) or you can find all this information on the Hunt 4-H website. Click **Major Show Tag Orders and Validation Dates** then toggle over to “**Fall Major Shows**”
2. Parents must complete entries in the State Fair of Texas Parent Portal PRIOR to bringing their completed **Youth Entry Worksheet** to the Hunt County Extension Office. Contest entries must complete the **State Fair of Texas Team Contest Entry Worksheet** and the **Hunt County 4-H Contest Exhibitor Checklist**. All junior show exhibitors are REQUIRED to complete Quality Counts. Click on the Quality Counts tab on our website to learn more. **On the County or FFA Chapter section on the Youth Entry and Team Worksheets, please put Hunt County 4-H, NOT your club name.**
3. Please bring **payment, completed Youth Entry Worksheet, and Hunt County 4-H Checklist** to the Hunt County Extension Office by noon **August 9th, 2024**. If entering a team, one representative should bring the **Hunt County 4-H Contest Entry Worksheet** and payment to the Hunt County Extension Office by noon **August 9th, 2024**. When bringing in entries, please allot time in your schedule for staff to quickly review entries for any potential errors.
4. Incomplete entries or those without the **Hunt County 4-H Checklist** or the **Hunt County 4-H Contest Entry Worksheet** will **NOT** be accepted. These forms are used to make the entry process more efficient for both exhibitors and office staff. Thank you for your cooperation and we look forward to seeing you soon!
5. After entries are turned in and processed, Hunt County AgriLife Staff will send **Academic Eligibility Forms** to the email listed on entry form or in 4-H Online. **Academic Eligibility Forms** are sent at least two weeks prior to the show or contest date, and must be signed by both parent and principal to determine the exhibitors academic eligibility. This is a **REQUIREMENT** for all 4-H members competing or participating in a 4-H sanctioned event that occurs during the school year, including homeschooled 4-Hers. Parents or guardians of homeschooled 4-Hers will fill out both the Parent/Guardian and Principal section.
6. Please check your spam folder then reach out to the office if you do not receive an **Academic Eligibility Form**. **Passes and other credentials will not be distributed until the signed Academic Eligibility Form is received by the Hunt County Extension Office. Eligibility Forms may be dropped off during business hours or emailed to hunt4h@ag.tamu.edu, at least one business day before the show or contest.** If emailing please send a scanned copy (preferred) or clear picture ensuring that the entire form is in frame.
